INVESTIGACIONES CULTURALES

Overview

Cultural investigations are activities within the community that are designed to help broaden your knowledge of the Hispanic culture in your everyday life and open your mind to reflecting about issues surrounding cultural similarities and differences. First, you must review the various activities to choose from online (msboter.weebly.com) or in open lab. Hard copies of the activities are available in the Independent Activities binder located in Ms. Boter's classroom. Then, you must choose and complete <u>one</u> activity second semester.

There are various activities designed to appeal to your different talents and interests. Some will be familiar to you, while others will be new experiences. For each activity you must complete and submit a **Cultural Investigation Research Sheet** as well as the **Guided Adventure Hand-out** associated with it (which includes a detailed explanation and instructions for that particular investigation). Cultural Investigations are to be completed independently and are considered summative assessments.

Grading Procedure

You must:

- 1.) Choose ONE activity to complete second semester
- 2.) Turn in the Guided Adventure Hand-out
- 3.) Turn in the Cultural Investigation Research Sheet
- 4.) Turn in a visual aid for each activity

Failure to complete a Cultural Investigation will result in a <u>DEMERIT</u>, and you will NOT receive credit for the course.
